

Dear PPS Families,

We've had a wonderful start to term 3 with lots of different things happening outside of the general classroom routine. In week 2 students were treated to a dance performance from Wesley College students as part of NAIDOC celebrations, there has been volleyball lessons running for year 2 – 6, and a Constable Care performance will be occurring today. Students have been displaying our STRIVE values well and receiving deserved recognition at Monday assemblies and through receiving STRIVE tags.

#### **Semester 2 Attendance Update**



Our attendance across the first 3 weeks of term 3 has started off well with an overall attendance rate of 89.1%. We have 71.4% of our students attending 90% or above, which is an improvement on semester 1. Our year 2 students have the best overall attendance rate of 96.6%, so well done to our year 2 class. Unauthorised attendances are currently sitting at 42% meaning a high number of absences are not being followed up with a note or SMS to the school. Please ensure that a note is sent to the class teacher or the office is notified if your child is / has been absent.

#### **Strategic Plan**

At last Tuesday's School Council meeting, our new 2019 – 2021 Strategic Plan was endorsed, setting the vision and direction for Pingelly PS across the next 3 years. The strategic plan seeks to continue building on our strengths, and address areas that we seek to improve. It outlines the strategies for how we will maintain existing approaches across teaching and learning, and what we will do to improve areas requiring attention. Overall, I am proud of our new strategic plan and the direction it sets, and the collaboration from staff, School Council and P&C representatives in developing this plan. #### **Behaviour Management Policy Update**

Also at last Tuesday's School Council meeting, updates to our Behaviour Management Policy were endorsed for immediate implementation. These updates add to our policy a good standing component and greater clarification on suspension of students for physical violence. These updates have been added in response to the Minister of Education's 10 point action plan to address violence in schools. Our policy reflects the Minister's instructions that students who start a fight or make physical contact with intent to harm are to be suspended from school. If such an incident occurs, the student loses good standing for a period determined by the Principal. For the duration that good standing is lost, the student is unable to attend any social or incentive-based events. ### School Dental Van

The school dental caravan will be commencing at Pingelly Primary School on the Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> August.

It is now the policy of Dental Health Services to try and have parents present when we do your child's dental examination. This enables a current *medical form* and *consent to treatment form* to be completed prior to any treatment being carried out. It is also a great time to answer any of your questions about your child's dental health.

If you receive the Medicare Child Dental Benefit Scheme rebate, please bring your Medicare card and let staff know at your appointment.

All students enrolled in the service will receive a recall appointment through the mail or via phone call. If you feel you should have received an appointment but do not get one please contact staff on 0437202882. If you need to change the appointment time please contact us so we can arrange a more suitable one for you. We may not have an up to date address or phone number.

If your child has not been enrolled in the school dental service, you will receive an enrolment form. Please complete and return it to the van, even if you do not want your child seen.

Students are eligible up to age of 17 or the end of year 11. If you have a student in

high school, even if they are not at Pingelly PS, and would like them to be seen, you can contact the dental van so we can organise enrolment and an appointment for you.
