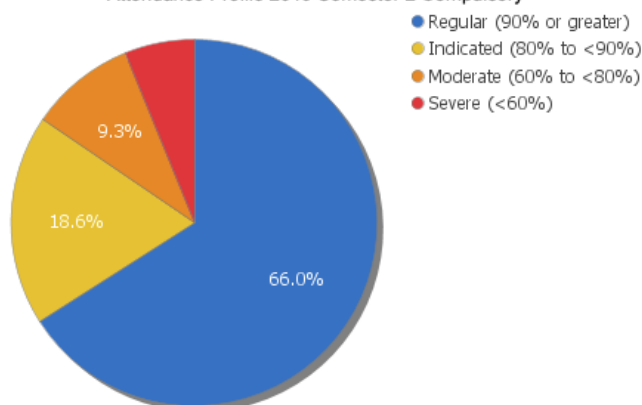

## Semester 2 Attendance Update

Attendance Profile 2019 Semester 2 Compulsory



Our overall attendance has decreased slightly from the end of week 5 and now sits at 89.3%. Regular attendance (90% or more) has also decreased since week 5 from 71% to 66%. Year 2 students continue to display strong attendance with an attendance rate of 94.1% and have lead the way all term. Our unauthorised absences have decreased from 50% to 20% which is a great outcome. Please continue to ensure that a note is sent to the class teacher or the office is notified if your child is / has been absent.

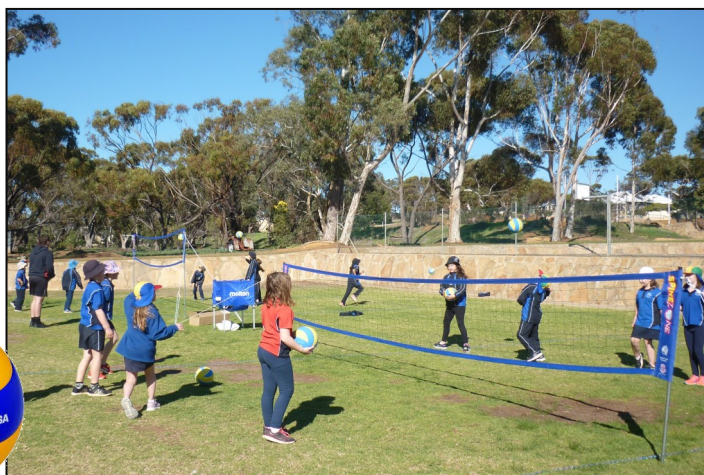
