


Dear PPS Families,

We have already passed the halfway point of term 1! I've seen wonderful learning happening in classrooms with students eager to engage with the various themes and topics. I've also quizzed students at our weekly assemblies on what STRIVE values they have been focusing on and how it has been linked across their classrooms. The students' responses have been very encouraging highlighting the impact STRIVE is having across our school.

#### Attendance

Student attendance has decreased slightly since last reported in week 4. The drop in regular attendance has seen an increase in students in the indicated and moderate categories. At the end of week 5, 68.4% of students have attended school regularly (90% of the time or greater). Our overall attendance rate for all year levels is 90.6% with kindergarten students our strongest attending students, with an overall attendance percentage of 94.7%. Please ensure that the school is informed of any absences either by SMS, or a note to your classroom teacher.



#### COVID-19 - (Coronavirus)

WA Public Schools receive regular COVID-19 updates from the Department of Education on advice from the Department of Health. The main message is that Western Australians should remain alert, but no be alarmed, and that as a school community, we apply a common sense, factual and practical approach. At this point in time, our best response is to ensure that information and messages are factual and consistent, and that we ensure that excellent hygiene practices are communicated, practiced and expected. To assist with this, our Health Nurse Kaylene Sewell will conduct hand washing workshops with students and staff and support the wider hygiene messages used across our school. We will also commence the display of hand washing related posters as an ongoing reminder to staff and students.
