## **COVID-19 Update**

It has been great having parents / caregivers back on grounds over the past two weeks. Whilst this is a step in the right direction, we are still not back to 'complete normal' with restrictions on adults in classrooms and other rooms, still in place. The ease of restrictions on parents / caregivers on school grounds only extends as far as open spaces. With this in mind, we ask that parents / caregivers refrain from walking around the school grounds during morning drop off and afternoon pick up.

Further developments to come from easing of COVID-19 restrictions is the rescheduling of faction and interschool carnivals. Last week the interschool sports committee met to review the recommencing of carnivals alongside current restrictions. This meeting led to the following schedule:

Week 2 Fri 31<sup>st</sup> July – interschool cross country @ <u>Brookton</u>

Week 6 Fri 28<sup>th</sup> Aug – faction athletics

Week 8 Fri 11<sup>th</sup> Sept – interschool athletics (primary only) @Beverley

Week 6 Fri 20<sup>th</sup> Nov – interschool swimming (could be primary only) @Pingelly

Based on current restrictions and health advice, the committee's restart plan includes the following:

No lunch orders

No spectators

Parent helpers are allowed/encouraged to assist with running of day

Hygiene stations set up – handwashing, sanitiser etc.

Plans are subject to change based on COVID-19 advice closer to event dates

Although it's disappointing that this plan excludes spectators, we can only plan for a restart of events using current health advice and compliance with social distancing and mass gathering restrictions. Based on the way 2020 has gone so far, plans could change rapidly between now and the commencement of these events. Otherwise, it is encouraging to be able to re-add events to the school calendar and plan for the running of these.
