

#### Attendance

Office staff have been spending a fair bit of time this term following up unexplained absences and overall poor attendance. The pie graph below provides an overview of term 3 attendance up to the end of week 3. The number of students in the *at risk, indicated* and *moderate* categories is concerningly high with only 55% of our students currently attending regularly.



#### **P&C** Donation

At yesterday's P&C meeting, a request from the school for funding support for interactive whiteboards, a replacement shade structure for the Cluster playground and new library furniture was generously granted. P&C will fund 3 new browser boxes for the library and contribute \$10,000 towards interactive whiteboards for years 2/3, 3/4 & 5/6, and \$10,000 towards a replacement permanent shade structure for the cluster playground. 
## Pre-Primary celebrate 100 Days of Learning
