Last Wednesday, the year 5/6 class made some scrumptious tacos! It was part of completing their maths project, which was to make a Taco Truck business.


Firstly, we made a recipe. We wrote a draft on lined paper, then got to decorate it and make it fancy in Publisher or Word.


