Dear Parents/Carers

I want to take this opportunity to thank you for your ongoing support throughout the COVID pandemic. Many of you received notification yesterday that as of tomorrow, Thursday 3 March 2022, our year 3-6 students are required to wear masks indoors at school. We understand that this may be challenging for many of our little ones and want to re-assure you that we are doing everything that we can to lesson the burden of wearing masks. This includes, increasing the number of brain breaks that students have outside and incorporating 'outdoor learning' opportunities into our daily teaching and learning programs. We ask that you provide your child with a mask each day, which we will send home at the end of the day to be sterilised and/or replaced. We do have some disposable masks here at school but our stocks are limited, so we really need your support. I tell my staff regularly that 'We're All In This Together' and I believe that working together is the only way that we are going to keep our kids, our staff and our Pingelly community safe as we navigate the unchartered waters of the COVID pandemic that lay ahead of us.

Relief staff are often called on at very late notice and will happily fill a role when asked.




You are all very much appreciated.
