Dear Parents/Carers

Strong partnerships between home and school are essential in ensuring that we get the best outcomes for our students. At Pingelly PS, we pride ourselves on being transparent with communication, and keep our community informed via See Saw, Facebook, text messages, phone calls and regular updates to our term planner on our web page. Schools are dynamic organisations (always changing) so please ensure that you regularly check our communication modes to keep abreast of any last minute changes.

Currently, the Department has a strong focus on restoring attendance to pre-COVID times. In saying that, COVID is still very much with us and that combined with the flu season has affected our overall attendance. We want to see your child/ren at school EVERY day, however if they have flu like symptoms, we do encourage you to keep them home. If they are unwell, please notify the school on the day of their absence. Within the next couple of weeks, schools will be provided with additional RAT tests. Each child receives an allocation of 20 RATs. This allocation supports the strategy to keep the school community COVID-19 safe. Use a RAT to test your child for COVID-19 if they have symptoms or are a household close contact. If your child is a close contact, they are permitted to attend school, as long as they receive a negative daily RAT result and remain asymptomatic. Students in year seven and above are required to wear a mask if they are a close contact.

Thank you for your efforts in keeping our students and community safe. I look forward to seeing you (and some sunshine hopefully) on Friday at our annual Faction Athletics Carnival.

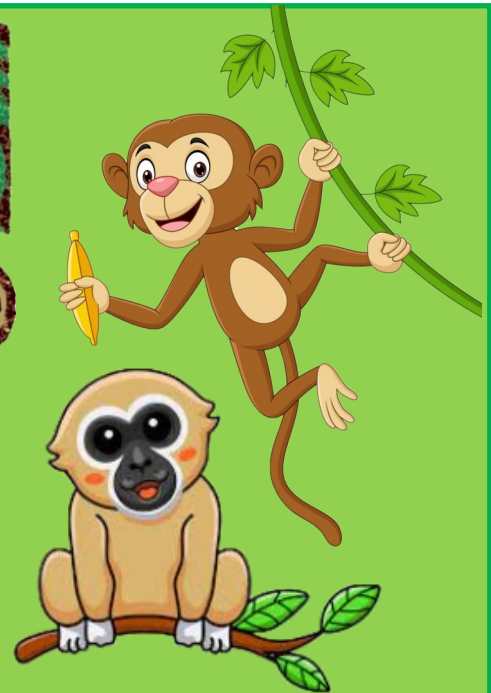
Class
