The App was developed by a team of psychologists and uses mindful breathing to boost calmness and manage stress, anxiety and improve general health and wellbeing for children... and adults alike! I'm looking forward to celebrating our achievements tomorrow by having a dance at our Easter Disco and wish to thank our local police and our dedicated P&C for organising the event for us. 
