## CHARGES FOR PRIMARY OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES 2024:

Charges apply for the provision of extra cost optional activities that are part of an education program and which 'contributions' do not cover. All activities outlined below are optional and if no payment is received, an alternative educational activity will be provided for your child.
The School Council has approved all 2024 extra cost optional activities. The estimated costs provided are at an upper limit and will not exceed the amount shown. If a particular event does not transpire within the school year, no charges for that event will apply.

Payment of the following charges is not required at the time of finalising payment of 'voluntary contributions'. Where staff arrange extra cost optional activities, payment will be requested immediately prior to it happening.

## Maximum Estimated Costs

Incursions will occur intermittently throughout the year.

- Camp

The School Council has agreed that the maximum charge to parents for any official school camp
$\$ 450.00$ should not exceed the figure shown. Should your child be involved in a class where a camp is coordinated, the actual cost may be much less depending on subsidisation by fundraising.
